**U.S. Army AMIS Announces pRFID II Contract Award**

*Alexandria, Va., May 20, 2013* – The U.S. Army Product Director, Automated Movement and Identification Solutions (PD AMIS), Program Executive Office Enterprise Information Systems (PEO EIS), Fort Belvoir, Va., announces award of the Passive Radio Frequency Identification II (pRFID II) Contract to SRA International, Inc. in March. The contract is a single award, Firm Fixed Price (FFP), Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) agreement for passive RFID (pRFID) technology to include hardware, software and technical engineering services. The contract has a ceiling value of \$30 million, and a period of performance consisting of a base of three (3) years (36 months) and two (2) one-year (12 month) options for pRFID technology solutions maintenance. PD AMIS offers pRFID products and solutions to Department of Defense (DoD), U.S. Coast Guard, NATO, Coalition Partners, other Foreign Military Sales (FMS) and other U.S. Government Federal Agencies.
