### United States (U.S.) Army PD AMIS Announces AIT-V Contract Award

*Alexandria, Virginia, 11 May 2015* – The U.S. Army Product Director, Automated Movement and Identification Solutions (PD AMIS), Program Executive Office Enterprise Information Systems (PEO EIS), Fort Belvoir, Virginia, announces award of the Automatic Identification Technology V (AIT-V) contracts. The contracts are de-centralized, multi-award, Firm Fixed Price (FFP), Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) for the acquisition of AIT technology to include hardware, software and technical engineering services.
